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Mr. Steinfeld and Mr. Conde will be speaking on solid waste flow control in Broward County and how this impacts code enforcement.

The discussion will explain the state definition of what is flow control of solid waste. Where solid waste by ordinance of cities in Broward must be deposited and why. The types of solid waste. Comparison of solid waste versus recovered materials pursuant to Florida law. How by State law and city ordinance, collection of the two must be enforced differently.

How franchises within Broward County are granted for solid waste by cities. Why it matters to cities financially to ensure franchises for solid waste are enforced. How recovered materials collectors violate city ordinances. How code enforcement of city ordinances regarding flow control of solid waste and municipal solid waste franchises. Pictorial examples of violations on the street. Discussion of topic.

Discussion of general code matters.

Eugene M. Steinfeld, is the City Attorney of Margate, District Counsel for the Broward Solid Waste Disposal District and serves as Hearing Officer/ Special Magistrate for a number of Broward cities. Mr. Steinfeld is recognized by the Florida Bar as an expert in City, County and Local Government law, which he has been practicing for over 35 years.

Andreas Conde, is the Solid Waste and Recycling Supervisor for the Broward County Solid Waste and Recycling Services. He coordinates enforcement of flow control for solid waste for Broward County.
