Bee Removal requires a delicate touch, especially when the honey bees need to be removed from within your residential or commercial property. Bee removal can also be tricky since most of the time all you will see is a dozen or so honey bees going in and out of a hole on your property. What most people don't expect and are surprised to find is that right behind that opening are thousands if not tens of thousands of bees helping build and protect the colony being established in the cavity. Once the cavity is opened and we expose the honeycomb, for most customers it is shocking to find that there can be 50, 60, even over 100+ lbs of honeycomb waiting to be removed if the hive has been there for a good amount of time. To see the where to look for bees and the most common spots bees build.

When engaging a bee removal company to get rid of bees, the first thing to check is that the company is licensed and insured. Proper bee removal will usually require opening the cavity that the bees are building in, whether it be the wall, roof or soffit of your property. The bee removal process is stressful enough without having to worry about whether the work will be done correctly. Proper licensing assures that the company is accountable for their work and that they have taken the time to get the continuous training and education requires.

The State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) Apiary Division recommends that all feral colonies or swarms near people or animals should be considered "Africanized" and eradicated by a pest control operator (PCO)

who has been specifically trained in honey bee colony extermination and removal. FDACS recommends that swarms and colonies should not be removed by beekeepers but only by PCOs.
